## Spotlight on the Artist

### Quilter and Artist **Becky Applebee**

#### 1. What motivates you to create and finish a quilt?

My motivation in creating a quilt can be a new pattern to try or a project such as the raffle quilt for the guild. Sometimes a quilt that I see at the guild meeting will inspire me to try something similar. When I started quilting I first made quilts for our 7 kids and now all 6 grands have one too. Sometimes it is a gift for weddings or other special events that is my motivation.

#### 2. Since you have other artistic ventures, how do they influence your quilt work?

I guess that all my experiences influence my quilt making. I am a birder and like the outdoors, I read a lot and enjoy many different kinds of music. I like to knit, do paper cutting and try different craft projects and to incorporate what I see and hear into all my work.

#### 3. How does living in Chiniak influence your art and quilting?

This goes along with #2 in that Chiniak is a great place to be with nature; we don't have TV so there is more time to read and work on quilting. We started a quilting group out here and the other members inspire me to try new things as well. Teaching is a great way to learn!

#### 4. Do you have a particular pattern that you like to work with?

I do like the cut out patterns and have adapted some paper cutting patterns to fabric. I also like a combination of piecing and appliqué which is what I did for the raffle quilt.

#### 5. When creating your design, does readily available material drive the quilt or is that secondary to the design itself?

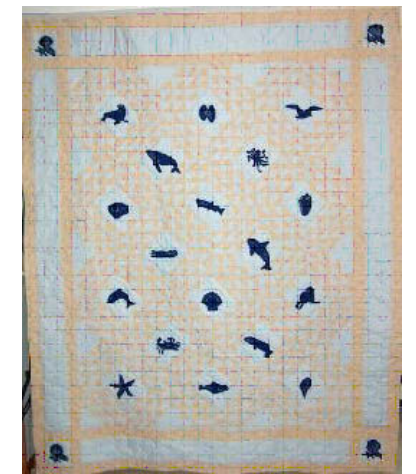
When creating a design the material is usually secondary to the design. I cannot always have or get my first choice of material so I make the material fit the design. I do a lot a scrappy quilts, using up as much leftover fabric as possible. It is a good way to recycle! Being out here in Chiniak I can't just run to the store if I run out or want something different so that makes me expand the possibilities as well.
